V. Incline unto my aid, O God.

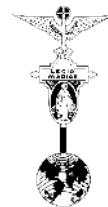
R. O Lord, make haste to help me.

May your continuous sight of God fill our memories with its
presence;
May the burning love of your heart inflame our lukewarm hearts;
May your virtues take the place of our sins;
May your merits be our ornament and supplement before God.
